These include: Infectious colitis. Ulcerative colitis (cause not known). Crohn's disease (cause not known). Ischemic colitis (caused by not enough blood going to the colon). Radiation colitis (after radiotherapy).

Gastrointestinal Disorders: Types, Symptoms & Treatment

Common problems include constipation, diarrhea, hemorrhoids, gastroenteritis, colitis, and irritable bowel disorders. Gastrointestinal problems can affect any part of the digestive system. The most common gastrointestinal problems — diarrhea and constipation — are common symptoms of many digestive disorders, but may also occur without an underlying disease.

What are the Most Common Gastrointestinal Problems?

The gallbladder is an organ attached to your intestine that stores bile—a digestive juice. Bile can form small, hard deposits called gallstones. About 20 million Americans have gallstones, but not all of them are a problem. Some gallstones don't cause symptoms and go away on their own. Others can cause severe pain or infection.
