This would also include the page numbers of a chapter, as shown in the example at the top of page 203, where it shows " (xx ed., Vol. xx, pp. xxx-xxx)" in the example. 2.

Instead, the Publication Manual, Sixth Edition states that "for substantial reference works with a large editorial board, naming the lead editor followed by et al. is acceptable" (p. 184). In other words, you can cite either all of the editors' names or just the first one followed by et al.
