Performance assessment is a summative assessment tool that is used as a substitute for high-stakes testing. It's intended to focus more on practical or applied skills—more “do you know how to use your knowledge?” versus “tell me what you know.” Other common terms include “authentic assessment” or “performance-based assessment.”

Performance Assessments Broadly speaking, performance assessment is any learning activity or assessment that asks students to perform or showcase their learning in order to demonstrate their knowledge, understanding and/or competencies, usually in a real-world context. It is often a key component of high-quality student-centered learning.

## **Performance Assessment in Different Learning Environments**

In general, a performance-based assessment measures students' ability to apply the skills and knowledge learned from a unit or units of study. Typically, the task challenges students to use their higher-order thinking skills to create a product or complete a process (Chun, 2010).

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The culminating activity or product for performance-based learning is one that lets a student demonstrate evidence of understanding through a transfer of skills. A performance-based assessment is open-ended and without a single, correct answer, and it should demonstrate authentic learning, such as the creation of a newspaper or class debate. The benefit of performance-based assessments is that students who are more actively involved in the learning process absorb and understand the material ...

A performance-based assessment measures a student's ability to apply the skills learned in an authentic way. The purpose of performance-based assessments is to determine a student's strengths or highlight a particular skill. A rubric may give some structure to this type of assessment.

Performance assessment is the “application of knowledge, skills, and work habits through the performance of tasks that are meaningful and engaging to students.” These tasks, occasionally marking gateways in learning, are “strategically placed in the lesson or unit to enhance learning as the student ‘pulls it all together’.”
