The SEAT Leon engine coolant temperature warning light comes on with ignition for a short time then goes out. This is normal procedure. There are two instances where this light may come on; constant or flashing. Constant: This means the engine coolant is overheating and/or there may be insufficient engine coolant. Do not continue driving.

The information panel on the right hand side said "EPC FAULT" & "ENGINE FAULT" I had the tyre indicator wear light on, the EPC light on, engine management light on & the stability control light.

The worst thing you can do when the light comes on is panic and switch the engine off. As said above, hold it at higher revs for a good long drive to clear the DPF out. Usually a good motorway drive in 3rd gear at around 3000rpm is good enough. Other thing you can do is get a bypass for it, have it mapped out, then it'll go better.

Engine management light Safe to drive? Yes - if it's always lit and there's no loss of power. You should get it checked as soon as possible. No - if it's flashing while you're driving. Avoid heavy acceleration and high engine speed. Stop the vehicle when it's safe to do so. Restart the engine after 2 minutes to reset the engine management system.

Flashing engine management light (amber) A flashing check engine light is likely to indicate a misfire in the engine, so the car may judder and will sound rough. Continued driving could overheat and damage the expensive catalytic converter, which is part of the exhaust system. You should immediately drive to a garage, using the accelerator gently.
