These matters can include divorces, estate distribution, injury cases, or even matters such as discrimination in the workplace. Criminal procedure applies to the process where the state or federal government is arresting and trying someone for a crime that was committed.

How is civil procedure different from criminal procedure?

In 1854, the fifth Legislature passed an act requiring the Governor to appoint a commission to codify the civil and criminal laws of Texas. Only the Penal Code and Code of Criminal Procedure, both authored by James Willie, were passed by the sixth Legislature and were effective as of February 1, 1857. These came to be referred to as the "Old Codes."
