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### Text Connections Lesson Plan 2nd

This Text-to-Text Connections Lesson Plan is suitable for 2nd Grade. Help youngsters make connections between two different texts. They read two stories about the same character, Ira Sleeps Over and Ira Says Goodbye. They discuss how the character of Ira acts in each of the stories, how he is the same or different.

### Text-to-Text Connections Lesson Plan for 2nd Grade ...

Have students work with the same partner to read the text for a second time together. Model to students how to choose one example from each type of text connection (text-to-self, text-to-text, and text-to-world). Mark the box and state your connections orally. For example:

There is a focus on students reading a certain number of words per minute, but not so much on whether or not they are comprehending what they have read. I concluded it was time for me to move on the next reading strategy, making connections. Activating scheming, text-to-self connections, making text connections all mean the same thing.

### Third grade Lesson Making Connections- Literary Text

Second graders connect reading to writing by making predictions, completing text to world connections, solving problems, and more. In this reading and writing lesson plan, 2nd graders draw conclusions after reading and write them down.

Some days, we'll write our connections on "links" and form chains. We've noticed that we've went from making ALL text-to-self connections to making all three types of connections! Yay!

### Reading Strategies: Connecting & Visualizing - Teaching ...

Explain to students that, in the first column, they should choose a quote or situation from the text that they can react to. Then, in the second column, they should record their reaction. Reinforce the fact that these reactions should make a connection between the text and themselves, another text, or the world.
