Who Has the Authority to Enforce Antitrust Laws? The authority to enforce antitrust laws is shared between the Federal Trade Commission (FTC) and the U.S. Department of Justice (DOJ). The FTC can file antitrust lawsuits in either federal court, or in an administrative hearing.
